

A Shortlist of Islamic Books for International Use for Preparing Advanced Persons/Scholars

1. One Tafsir of the Quran, preferably of Sayed Qutb or Maulana Maududi (Fi Zilalil Quran/Tafhimul Quran) 2/3 times. Translation of whole Quran in local language/English 2/3 times
 2. A book on USUL Al Fiqh by Dr Hasim Kamali/shah abdul hannan/ any other scholar in English/local language 3/4 times.
 3. A biography of the Prophet Sallallahu Alaihe Wa Sallam in English/Arabic/local language 3/4 times
 4. A book on Akida , preferably Akidatul Islam by Muhammad al Gazali in Arabic/English / local language 2/3 times
 5. Tauhid by Ismail Raji Al Faruqi in English/ local language 1/2 times
 6. Sahih Bukhari/ Muslim in English/ Arabic/ local language at least once*with commentary if available in your language
 7. Freedom of Women in Prophet's time by Abdul Halim Abu Shukkah, vol--1,2, in English/Arabic/ local language 2/3 times
 8. Approaching the Sunnah by Yusuf Al Qaradawi in Arabic/English/ local language 2/3 times
 9. The Lawful and Prohibited in Islam by Yusuf Al Qaradawi in English/local language 2/3 times
- Note1-In addition, as many books as possible of major Islamic writers should be read.
 - Note2--The target should be to prepare at least fifty scholars in each Muslim country/in each sizable Muslim community in non-Muslim countries.
